## <u>IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS</u> ADMISSIONS TO PROFESSIONAL DEGREE COURSES 2016-17

From year 2016-17, admissions to BAMS (Gomantak Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya & Research Centre, Shiroda) would be based on GCET-2016 (Goa Common Entrance Test).

## Eligibility Criteria for admissions to First Year BAMS is at par with MBBS, BDS, BHMS AHS as specified below:

a) Applicant should have passed the Higher Secondary Certificate (Std. XII) examination of Goa Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with English and secured not less than 50% marks in the aggregate of subjects of Physics, Chemistry, and Biology taken together. (40% for the applicants belonging to SC, ST and OBC only and 45% for applicants belonging to PH category for MBBS and BDS Course).

## b) <u>Admissions to B.Sc. Course in Nursing at Institute of Nursing Education, Bambolim has</u> been revised:

Applicants should have passed HSSC (qualifying exam) in subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English, and obtained minimum 45% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology for General Category, (40% aggregate marks in subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology for candidates belonging to SC,ST and OBC category).

C) <u>Guidelines for Merit List preparation: MBBS, BDS, BHMS, BAMS and AHS</u> (Additional tiebreaker provisions are introduced in respect of Merit Lists preparations for MBBS, BDS, BHMS, BAMS and AHS in order to simplify Merit Lists preparation in case of tie).

For admissions to Medicine, Dentistry, Homeopathy, Ayurveda, Allied Health Sciences & B.Sc. Nursing, merit lists would be prepared based on GCET-2016 scores, as stated below:

- a. The merit list shall be based on aggregate marks of GCET-2016 in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology. The candidates who have secured at least 50% aggregate (40% for SC/ST/OBC, & 45% for PH in MBBS and BDS course) in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Biology at GCET- 16 shall be considered for merit list for MBBS and BDS. There shall be no minimum marks for BHMS, BAMS, AHS & Nursing.
- b. In case the above marks of two or more applicants are equal, applicant with more marks in **Biology at GCET-2016** shall be placed higher in the merit list.
- c. In case the marks in Biology are also equal, applicant with more marks in **Chemistry at GCET-2016** will be placed higher in the merit list.
- d. In case the marks in GCET-2016 in Chemistry are also equal, applicant with higher aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at qualifying exam (Std.XII<sup>th</sup>) will be placed higher in merit list.
- e. In case of tie at this stage, applicants securing more marks in Biology at qualifying exam (Std. XII<sup>th</sup>) will be placed higher in the merit list.
- f. In case marks in Biology in qualifying exam are also equal, applicant with higher marks in Chemistry at qualifying exam(Std. XII<sup>th</sup>) will be placed higher in the merit list.
- g. If all the above are also equal, then the applicant with earlier date of birth will be placed higher in the order of merit.

Intending applicants for admissions to **BAMS** (Gomantak Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya & Research Centre, Shiroda), may note that they need to appear at GCET-2016(Goa Common Entrance Test).

Accordingly Common Prospectus, containing relevant details pertaining to admissions to First Year of Professional Degree Courses (MBBS,BDS,BHMS, BAMS, B.E., B.Pharm, B.Arch., AHS & B.Sc.Nursing) in the State of Goa, for the year 2016-17, including GCET-2016 (Goa Common Entrance Test), to be conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2016 shall be uploaded on the website of this Directorate www.dtegoa.gov.in., by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2016.
