PROFESSIONAL DEGREE COURSE ADMISSIONS 2019-20

All intending applicants for admissions to First Year of Professional Degree Courses (MBBS, BDS, BHMS, BAMS, B.E., B.Pharm, B.Arch., AHS & B.Sc.Nursing) in the State of Goa, in the year 2019-20, may note that the Common Prospectus containing information on GCET-2019 (Goa Common Entrance Test-2019), as well as admissions, together with forms (Form GCET & Form A/B/C), required to be filled up and submitted on respective dates at specified locations, is available on the website of this Directorate www.dte.goa.gov.in. The Prospectus also contains information on admissions to students from Goa State in B.V.Sc. & A.H. Degree course for the seats reserved, in Institutions outside Goa State.

Print version of Common Prospectus shall NOT be made available on sale by this Directorate.

Therefore, applicants may download, print and submit the GCET application form, as well as other relevant admission forms, on specified dates, with copies of specified documents, at specified locations, as stated in the Table below:
