**IMPORTANT NOTICE: SPOT ADMISSION ROUND TO
PROFESSIONAL DEGREE AND DIPLOMA COURSES**

Eligible and interested applicants desirous of availing admissions to vacant seats (including EWS seats) in Degree and Diploma courses, at end of respective admission round, may register their names **in person**, by submitting specified application forms, together with copies of essential documents as specified, and payment of application fee, as per following **Schedule**:

First and Second Year of Diploma Courses	Wednesday, 14th August, 2019 (3.00 p.m.)	Wednesday, 14th August, 2019 at 4.00 p.m.

*Candidates who fulfil eligibility criteria for admissions to Engineering Degree courses, **not having answered GCET** shall also be considered for admissions, subject to the following:

1. Admissions shall be first offered to interested, eligible candidates having answered GCET, followed by ;

2. Eligible candidates who have not appeared at GCET, but fulfil other prescribed academic eligibility criteria by AICTE and Goa University. Merit List for such candidates would be prepared on the basis of aggregate marks scored in relevant subjects of Physics and Mathematics, at qualifying exam (Std XIIth), conducted by Goa Board, followed by students qualifying from other State Board.

During the above Rounds, only eligible applicants, appearing in **Person**, will be considered for admissions, on **MERIT**, as per following priority:

- a) Eligible candidates fulfilling General Category criteria followed by
- b) Eligible local applicants (LA) (candidates passing qualifying exam in the State) followed by
- c) Eligible outside Goa applicants (OGA).
- d) Non-GCET candidates, wherever applicable.

Candidates attending above rounds shall carry originals of all specified documents (together with certified copies thereof), and fees payable for respective course.
