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PART I

1. INTRODUCTION

Goa Medical College complex is situated at Bambolim, Goa. Goa Medical College was established by upgrading the old “Escola Medica-Cirurgica de Goa”. Medical education was existent in Goa for more than 100 years and scores of doctors, some of them who achieved international recognition, passed through the old school. The college therefore, has more than 100 years tradition in medical education. Bachelor Degree courses in various Allied Health Sciences are being conducted at Goa Medical College since academic year 2013-14 and till date, 5 batches have successfully completed their undergraduate Degree courses. The Allied Health Science Courses are affiliated to Goa University and is under the administrative control of the Government of Goa. Understanding the need and scope of the specialised post-graduate courses, Goa Medical College has commenced the Post-Graduate Degree courses in various Allied Health Sciences from the academic year 2020-2021.

2. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE INSTITUTE

- a. To impart necessary knowledge and practical training techniques in Post-Graduate Degree courses in Allied Health Sciences, and to maintain high standards of Allied Health Sciences education
- b. To render competency in knowledge and skills related to advance Allied Health Sciences, especially related to speciality Clinical fields to enhance Professional Practice, Education and Research, in line with global standards.
- c. To attain self-sufficiency in Post-Graduate Allied Health Sciences education to meet State’s need of Allied Health Sciences personnel with speciality qualification.

3. COURSES OF STUDY & DURATION

6. BOND

The candidate admitted to the Postgraduate Degree courses in Allied Health Sciences will be required to execute an indemnity Bond that they will serve the Government of Goa for a period of ONE year, on completion of Postgraduate Degree course. The Government may post them in any health facility within the State of Goa. If a candidate leaves the course without completing the same, or violates any of the conditions of the Bond, they will be liable to a penalty of 50 lacs, as per the Government of Goa guidelines.

7. HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION

Hostel facilities are available at the campus and admission to the hostel will be governed by the hostel rules and will be subject to availability of accommodation.

8. ANTI-RAGGING

- a. RAGGING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED, AS PER THE GOA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 2008: GOA ACT 9 OF 2009 AND GOA ACT 17 OF 2010. ANY STUDENT/STUDENTS WHO IS /ARE FOUND GUILTY OF RAGGING AND /OR ABETTING RAGGING IS/ARE LIABLE FOR PUNISHMENT.
- b. On admission, every student shall register affidavits online affirming to the effect that he/she has not been expelled and/or debarred by any institution for

any act of ragging and further that he/she will not indulge actively or passively, in the act or abet the act of ragging and if found guilty of ragging and/or abetting ragging will be liable for punishment. A copy of anti-ragging affidavit shall be submitted within 30 days of admission.

- c. Punishment for ragging
 - i. Whoever directly or indirectly, commits, participates in, abets or propagates, ragging, within or outside this institute shall, on conviction, be dealt with by the Director of the institute and resorted to disciplinary action.
 - ii. If the individuals committing or abetting ragging are not identified, collective punishment will be reported as a deterrent punishment and to ensure collective pressure on the potential raggers.
 - iii. Any student so convicted shall further be removed from the roll of the institution and such students shall not be admitted in any other educational institution in the state of Goa for a period of three years from the date of such conviction.
- iv. The punishment may also take the shape of:
 - 1. Debarring from representation in events;
 - 2. Withholding results; and
 - 3. Suspension or expulsion from institute
- d. The migration certificate shall include an entry of whether the student had indulged in ragging and in particular was punished for ragging, apart from the student's general conduct and behaviour.

9. MISCELLANEOUS

- 9.1. Students shall follow rules in respect of use of the Institute's library and laboratory facilities. They shall also follow the rules and regulations where they gain their practical experience.
- 9.2. Students are required to be immunized against hepatitis-B before the commencement of their practical experience.
- 9.3. Attendance: Students require to have a minimum of 80% attendance in theory and 80% in practical), to be eligible to appear for the examination
- 9.4. Facilities for periodical medical examination, outdoor/indoor medical treatment will be provided in the hospital attached in the college.
- 9.5. The students who failed to observe discipline in the college will be dealt with according to the rules and regulations laid down by the college
- 9.6. Stipend: Stipend will be paid as per appropriate rate fixed by Government of Goa and revised from time to time. Stipend for AHS courses is subject to Government approval.

PART- II

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

For admission to the Postgraduate Degree courses in Allied Health Sciences included in this prospectus, an applicant must fulfil the following criteria:

- 1.1. Nationality:** Admission to Post-Graduate Allied Health Science Courses at Goa Medical College is open to Indian Nationals fulfilling other eligibility criteria. Non-Resident Indians (NRI), Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) and Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs) holding Indian passport may also apply.
- 1.2. Age:** The candidate must have completed the age of 18 years on or before 31st December 2024. No maximum age limit, is specified for admission.

1.3. Qualifying examination and Minimum marks:

- 1.3.1.** For MPT, and MOT courses, candidates should have passed the Under-Graduate Degree exam in respective course from Goa University, or any other UGC recognised University and for M.Sc. Echocardiography, candidates

should have passed either B.Sc. Degree in Medical Imaging Technology (MIT) in Radiodiagnosis or B.Sc. Degree in Cardiac Care technology from Goa University, or any other UGC recognised University.

1.3.2. For the admission to the postgraduate degree courses in Allied Health Sciences, the candidates belonging to the General Category will be required to obtain minimum 50% aggregate marks, and the candidate belonging to the reserved categories (Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes) will be required to obtain minimum 40%, aggregate marks (The percentage of aggregate marks shall be arrived at by totalling the marks obtained in all the subjects of all academic years of respective under-graduate Allied Health Science Courses.)

1.3.3. Candidates must have completed stipulated Compulsory Rotatory Internship **on or before 15/04/2025.**

ADMITTING AUTHORITY:

State Government has approved that Directorate of Technical Education, which is the designated Counselling Authority for conducting admissions to Post Graduate Degree courses at Goa Medical College shall also carry out admissions to Post Graduate Degree courses in Allied Health Sciences at Goa Medical College.

2. APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

2.1. The application form enclosed to the Prospectus (Annexure-IV) can be obtained online on the website of Directorate of Technical Education (www.dte.goa.gov.in) or Goa Medical College (www.gmcgoa.edu.in). or collected in person from Office of Directorate of Technical Education or Goa Medical College.

2.2. Applicant needs to pay application fee of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) at the time of submission of the application form.

2.3. The application form duly filled along with self-attested copies of testimonials/ certificates can be submitted in person at Directorate of Technical Education, Porvorim or sent by Registered/Speed Post to Directorate of Technical Education, Porvorim –Goa 403521. Online submission of application form along with self attested documents in pdf format may be submitted to dtegoaadm-deg@gov.in. The application form for admission should reach the Directorate of Technical Education, Porvorim, on or before **28/03/2025**.

2.4. Candidates must ensure that they fulfil the specified eligibility criteria before the last date of submission of application.

3. TESTIMONIALS AND CERTIFICATES REQUIRED

All candidates shall enclose with their application form, self-attested copies of the following documents:

1. Certificate of birth from the competent authority.
2. Certificate of passing and statement of marks obtained at S.S.C., H.S.S.C. Examinations
3. Provision/Degree Certificate, statement of marks, Attempt Certificate, Passing Certificate, and Internship Completion Certificate obtained for relevant Bachelor degree in respective Allied Health Science courses issued by UGC recognized university.
4. Leaving/Transfer certificate from college last attended, duly signed by the Dean/Principal of the Institution (as applicable).
5. Migration Certificate issued by the recognized University (If Bachelor's Degree obtained from other than Goa University).
6. Provisional Eligibility Certificate from Goa University (for candidates not passing qualifying Degree exam from Goa University)
7. Certificate that the candidate has been immunized against Hepatitis-B must be attached.

8. Certificates received after the specified due date will NOT be considered.

4. FOR CLAIMING SPECIFIC CATEGORIES

6. INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1.** Applications which are incomplete or submitted after the due date and time as notified will not be considered.
- 6.2.** All certificates enclosed with the application form should be self-attested.
- 6.3.** Copies of certificates attached with the application form will not be returned even if the candidate is not selected.
- 6.4.** No original certificates should be attached to the application.
- 6.5.** The candidate will have to produce certificates in original for verification at the time of admission.

6.6. PHOTOGRAPHS

All Candidates must

- a. Affix their recent passport size photograph on the application form after which the same is to be self-attested
- b. Submit an additional copy of the photograph with their names written in pencil on the reverse of the photograph

6.7. If for any genuine reason, a candidate is unable to submit the required certificates the candidate shall be provisionally admitted. She/he must provide an undertaking indicating that all the certificates shall be submitted within a period of 3 (three) days from the date of admission. **Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.** However, candidates cannot be admitted without the Eligibility Certificate from Goa University.

7. GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION/ADMISSION

7.1 All candidates are required to appear at “**Entrance Test (ET)**”. Details of Entrance Test shall be duly notified to the applicants. Separate Entrance Test shall be conducted for MPT, MOT and M.Sc. ECHO courses.

7.2 The Merit list for admissions shall be determined on the basis of marks scored at the Entrance Test for respective course.

7.3 If two or more candidates secure the same marks in the Entrance Test, the merit list shall be prepared by adopting the following tie breaker rules

- (a) On the basis of the total percentage marks secured by the candidates in the aggregate of all academic years of respective under-graduate Allied Health Science course, followed by:
- (b) Total marks secured by the candidates in the final academic year of respective under-graduate Allied Health Science course, followed by:

- (c) Total marks of third academic year of respective under-graduate Allied Health Science course followed by:
 - (d) Total marks of second academic year of respective under-graduate Allied Health Science course followed by:
 - (e) Total marks of first academic year of respective under-graduate Allied Health Science course.
- 7.4. Single merit list shall be prepared for each of the courses (MPT, MOT, M.Sc.ECHO). candidates shall opt for specific specialisation Degree course, based on his/her merit and choice at the time of Counselling. The merit list shall additionally indicate the Reserved Categories of the applicants wherever applicable. viz. SC. ST, OBC, PwD.
- 7.5 Merit list of all eligible candidates shall be prepared as per following groups in order of precedence:

Group- I:

Candidates who have completed AHS Degree from Goa University and satisfactorily completed full internship at institutions affiliated to Goa University, followed by:

Group-II:

Candidates who have completed AHS Degree from Goa University and have completed their internship outside Goa, in an institution recognized by the UGC, followed by:

Group-III:

Candidates who have completed AHS Degree from an institution recognized by UGC, which is not affiliated to Goa University, and completed their internship in institution affiliated to Goa University, followed by:

Group-IV:

Candidates who graduated from, and completed their internship from an institution recognized by the UGC, and not affiliated to Goa University.

- 7.6 SC, ST, OBC and PwD applicants fulfilling the specified criteria of Group I will be considered for seats as per the Table above.
- 7.7 All seats shall first be allotted to candidates in Group-I. Group-II, Group-III and Group-IV merit list will be sequentially operated, only after Group-I merit list is exhausted viz. there are no eligible applicants remaining in Group-I, and vacant seats are available.
- 7.8 Admission Committee shall allot seat on the basis of Merit and Choice of options exercised by the candidates at the time of Counselling.
- 7.9 candidates shall be required to report to the Institution after allotment, for completion of further formalities, including payment of fees. Allotment of seat to candidate who do not report to the institution and/or fail to complete required formalities, including payment of fees, by specified date, shall stand cancelled.
- 7.10 In case any seats remain vacant due to non-availability of eligible candidate belonging to SC, ST, OBC and PwD categories, the same shall be offered to candidate from GEN category.
- 7.11 **Designated Counseling Authority/Admission Committee** shall notify and conduct as many additional rounds of allotment, as may be necessary, based on the vacancy position and guidelines of Goa University.
- 7.12 In order to ensure the smooth conduct of admission/allotment process, Designated Counselling Authority/Admission Committee reserves the right to modify/amend the procedure of allotment/admission, at any stage, during the process of admission.
- 7.13 All the applicants selected for admission shall be required to be first examined by the Medical Board of Goa Medical College, Bambolim, Goa and only those found medically fit, shall be admitted to these courses.

7.14 Admitted candidates are required to sign a bond with the Government/Institution for specified amount. Details regarding the bond, may be ascertained from the Institute. The selected candidates for the admission shall be required to execute bond (as per specimen to be obtained from the college) that they will serve Government (of Goa) for a period of 1 (ONE) year, on completion of respective AHSC PG course.

8. NOTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY AND MERIT LIST

8.1 The eligibility and Merit lists of the candidates shall be notified on DTE website www.dte.goa.gov.in as well as on the website of Goa Medical College www.gmcgoa.edu.in

8.2 Candidates shall bring to the notice of the Admission Committee any discrepancy in the eligibility and merit list within 24 hours of notification, failing which the candidate himself/herself shall be responsible for the consequence of such an error.

8.3 The provisionally selected candidates should report to the Goa Medical College, Bambolim, Goa on the date and time as notified along with the fees and their original certificates for verification. Fees are to be paid by Demand Draft drawn or through online mode as per details mentioned in Fee structure section. Admission shall be confirmed only upon verification and submission of original documents, and payment of fees.

9 CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

9.1 Candidates not reporting:

9.1.1 If any candidate who is offered admission does not report or pay the prescribed fees within the date specified, the admission will be treated as cancelled, and seat will be offered to the next eligible waitlisted candidate.

9.1.2 Even if a candidate pays the tuition fees, but fails to join the College by specified date, the admission of the candidates is liable to be cancelled. The tuition fees paid by such candidate shall not be refunded.

9.2 Cancellation of Admission by Admitting Authority:

9.2.1 If any information/certificate submitted by the candidate in connection with her/his admission is found to be incorrect at any time in the future, her/his admission shall be cancelled forthwith and Bond penalty charges will be applicable.

9.2.2 Admission fee of (Rs.2000/-) (Rupees two thousand only) shall not be refunded under any circumstances on cancellation of admission.

9.2.3 If a candidate desires to cancel his/her admission for any reason whatsoever within one month of start of academic term, her/his admission fees, and 10% of tuition fees, shall be deducted, and . remaining other fees will be refunded.

9.2.4 If a candidate cancels the admission after one month from the start of academic term, bond will be applicable to the candidate.

10 REFUND OF FEES

Fees shall be refunded on submission of an application from the Candidate requesting for cancellation of admission and only on production of the original fee receipt. **Mode of refund payment will be through ECS credited to the candidate's bank account.**

All changes which come into effect after the prospectus is notified, shall be displayed on the website of Directorate Technical Education and Goa Medical College.
